Graduates: Meet at the high school at 2:30 wearing your cap and gown. Please have a parent or guardian drive you so you can enjoy waving. Arrive at the school with your car already decorated as you wish. Park in the student parking lot with your vehicle facing toward the tennis courts and wait in your car to be directed into the line up. Do NOT get out of your car or congregate in groups. The parade will be led around the back of the SCHS building to Taylorsville Road through historic downtown to SCES where we will travel the loop around SCMS and back through downtown returning to SCHS. Once at the high school, please go home and do not get out of your vehicle. We are following the governor's restrictions for social distancing and maximum group size.

Friends, family, and community members: Please join us in celebrating the graduates as they drive through town. We are NOT reserving spots for family members alongside the roadway as once planned. You are invited to park on both sides of Taylorsville Road that leads from the high school to the turn for downtown. You are also invited to park on the stretch of Hwy 44 to SCES. You may even park along side of the drive that leads beside SCES and the loops around SCMS as well as in the SCMS front parking lot. You are encouraged to stake out your spot early as the parade will pull out of the high school at 3:00 and we do not want you to miss any of the graduates. Please realize that this is not the typical parade style where people crowd together to view the floats. We highly encourage everyone to remember to socially distance by either staying in the car or standing beside their car as the parade passes by. Please stay safe by wearing your mask and not congregating in crowds of 10 or more. The parade will be led by a school bus and finishes with the mascot bear, but don't leave your spot because after we make the turn around SCMS you will get to see all the graduates a second time as they return back to the high school.
